- As per the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India's ruling May 2007, strict penal action be taken against those involved in ragging or any indecent/ dishonorable towards freshers. The Hon'ble court has also asked the local police to file FIR's and take strict penal action against the culprits.
- **One or more of the disciplinary actions given below may be taken against a student involved in ragging :**
- Expulsion from the institute
- Rustication
- Financial penalty as recommended by the administrative Board
- Deduction of General Proficiency Marks
- In case of failure in identification of any particular student involved in ragging, the entire group present on the scene of occurrence is liable to be punished severely as mentioned above.



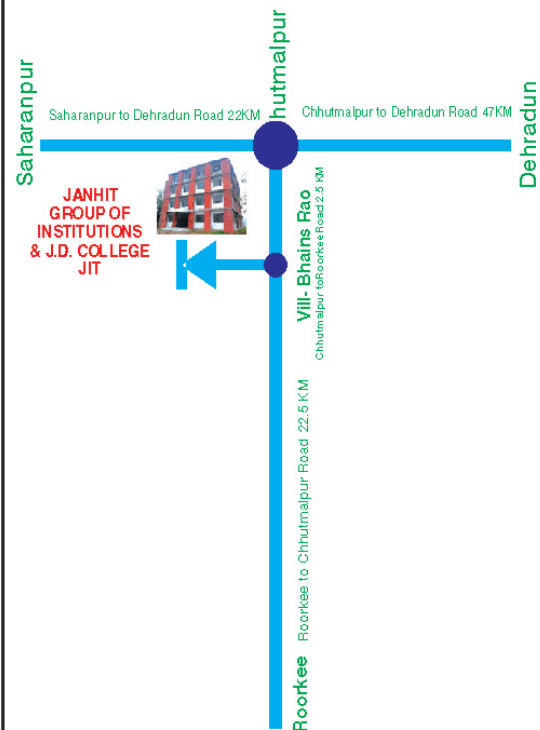
## LOCATION MAP
